What is Expected of Each Student?

The following are the rules and conduct for each camper attending Middle School Beach Camp

1. Campers will attend all required rallies, Bible studies, quiet times, crew times, devotionals, worship services, etc. Campers will also be responsible for following the schedule.
2. Campers will not possess any alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances, fireworks, lighters, matches, or weapons of any kind (campers which are on prescribed medication **MUST** notify nurse at check-in).
3. Campers will not use profane or abusive language at any time for any reason.
4. Campers will not engage in fighting, brawling, pranks, or practical joking on other campers (i.e., shaving cream, etc.)
5. Campers will complete all assigned responsibilities, such as KP and TP duty (Kitchen and Toilet Patrol).
6. Campers will cooperate with **all leaders always.**
7. **Cell phones are not allowed outside of free time! DBC is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.**
8. Campers will not enter the dorm of the opposite gender for any reason **EVER!**
9. Campers will not wear revealing clothing and will comply with all rules outlined on the parent information sheet.
10. Campers will not use fire escapes and will not open fire doors except in the case of an emergency.
11. Campers will not use cabin equipment and/or furniture for uses other than their intended purpose.
12. Campers will not mess with or use anything which belongs to another camper without their permission.
13. Campers must stay in groups of 3 or more.
14. No public or private displays of affection.

PARENT INFORMATION

Departure Information: Student check-in will be from 7-7:45 AM on Monday, June 25th at the Refuge. We will load the buses at 8 am and depart by 8:10 AM.

Return Information: We will return on Friday, June 29th at approximately 7pm. Buses will unload at the Refuge.

Students will need to pack the following items in ONE MEDIUM sized suitcase: PLEASE PUT YOUR NAME ON ALL OF YOUR BELONGINGS.

- Bible , pen & notepad
- Bedding
- Two beach towels and swimsuit (**No two-piece swimsuits allowed**)
- Bath towels
- Tennis shoes, sandals, or flip flops
- Casual clothes (shorts/T-shirts, etc. We will not dress up for anything)
- Personal articles (deodorant, soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush)
- Strong sunscreen lotion (recommend SPF 50 or higher) & sunglasses
 - Extra spending money for: snacks, food, Tshirt/Souvenirs/Sea Shack

Do not bring: alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, firearms, knives, drugs, fireworks, balloons, balloon launchers, or inappropriate T-shirts, "short" shorts (see requirement below), bikinis, tight clothing, tank tops (see requirement below), tube tops, halter tops or other revealing clothing.

GIRLS: must wear one-piece swimsuits (no tankinis) If a bathing suit is deemed inappropriate by a staff member, students will be provided with a dark t-shirt and shorts. Shorts must come to fingertip length and tank tops must have straps that are two fingers wide.

BOYS: swimming trunks must come to at least 2 inches above the knee.
